New Member's Academy takes place on Sundays at 9:30am during the Sunday School period with the exception of the First Sunday of each month. On that Sunday, there is General Sunday School, when all classes assemble together for one session.

The Modules I-VIII are continuously repeated. You can begin when either module is being taught; however, you should complete all eight.

## HOW DO I BEGIN MY NEW LIFE IN CHRIST?

Let us help you! All new members should begin by attending New Members' Academy. This is an eight-week course of study in which you will learn:

- Who we are
- What we believe
- How we operate, and
- Where you fit in

Another great benefit of New Members' Academy is the opportunity to learn how to listen to and be led by **G**od. **J**esus saved us so we could enjoy a relationship with **H**im now!

New Members' Academy is held each Sunday at 9:30 am in the rear area of the Fellowship Hall. Keep the following truths in mind as you begin your relationship with **J**esus **C**hrist.

#### You Are Saved!

Now that you have taken a public stand and confessed your faith in the Lord **J**esus **C**hrist (Romans 10:8-10), you are a member of **G**od's family and a prime target for Satan (John 10:10). The enemy will bring circumstances into your life that will test your trust in **G**od. Please do not be moved by what you see, what you hear or what you feel, but only by the <u>fact</u> that salvation is the gift of **G**od through which you have inherited eternal life (Romans 6:23; Ephesians 2:8-9). The word salvation is translated from the Greek word 'soteria' which means deliverance, safety, preservation, soundness, and healing. When we receive Jesus as the **L**ord of our lives, we receive **G**od's total package of love! Take the time to review these scriptural references: John 1:12; Acts 4:12; Romans 1:16; and Galatians 2:19-20.

#### Jesus Commanded Water Baptism

After you confess **C**hrist, you are baptized as **C**hrist commanded (Matthew 28:18-20). Baptism is an outward sign of the inward grace (gift) of salvation. To be baptized is to be submerged or placed into water. It represents that you have died to sin and self, and now live a new life in and through **C**hrist. When you are placed into the water you identify with **H**is death and when you come up out of the water you identify with **H**is

resurrection. Water symbolizes the **W**ord of **G**od – water cleanses dirt like the **W**ord of **G**od cleanses sin. See John 6:63, 15:3 and Romans 6:3-5.

#### You Are Not The Same Anymore!

2 Corinthians 5:17 says, "*Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.*" You will begin to experience this newness in an intense desire to study and understand **G**od's **W**ord, to associate with other Christians, to avoid committing sin, and to do the work that **G**od has specifically planned for you to perform. Our New Members' Academy will help acquaint you with ministries in which you can fulfill your **G**od-given purposes. See 1 Peter 2:2 and 1 John.

#### You Should Begin to Pray and Read the Bible Daily

Daily prayer is communicating with the **G**od of creation, your **H**eavenly Father, and is essential to your Christian walk. As you begin to seek God daily, asking **H**im to reveal **H**is will for your life, **H**e will reward you through understanding His Word and His Will for you, and will provide you with the comfort and peace of **H**is Holy presence. **H**e wants you to get to know **H**im in a personal way through prayer, so your communication should be open and honest, and you should take the time to sit quietly before Him to receive **H**is instructions. Our prayers should always include praise, honor, thanksgiving, confession of sin, and request for forgiveness and cleansing before we begin to make our requests known to **H**im. Prayer is also praying God's Word over the circumstances of your life, putting God in remembrance of what **H**e has said about your life. Therefore, in order to pray accurately, you must know what **G**od's **W**ord says – daily Bible reading and meditation are essential. Review Psalms 1; Psalms 119; Matthew 6:5-13, 7:7; Ephesians 6:18-19; 1 Thessalonians 5:17; Hebrews 4:16; James 5:16; and 1 John 1:9-10.

## **Five Areas of Involvement**

**Consistent Givers** are those who give regularly and sacrificially to the church by being dependable even when absent; "to give cheerfully and regularly to the support of the ministry, the relief of the poor, and the spread of the Gospel throughout all nations"

2 Corinthians 9:6-7 But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.

**Ministry Workers** are those who give their time and talents faithfully to serve as an usher, as a choir member, as a youth worker, etc. . .

Philippians 2:12-13 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.

**Consistent Worshippers** are those who are loyal and devoted in their attendance.

John 4:23 But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

**Lifelong Learners** are those who are dedicated to furthering their Christian Education by attending Sunday school, Bible class, Greater Excellence Ministry School (GEMS), etc.

2 Timothy 2:15 *Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.* 

**Soul Winners** are those who are zealous in their efforts to advance the Kingdom of our **S**avior by evangelizing their families, friends, and the lost.

Matthew 28:18-20 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."
